## **Director of Funding & Partnerships**

*Description:* As part of the core Management Team, you will develop and execute Stardust Startups' fundraising operations by coordinating and leading the Funding & Outreach Team (made of interns and volunteers).

#### Goals

- Attract large-amount, (ideally recurring) donations from funders to foster financial stability and sustainability for Stardust.
- **Dual focus** on institutional donors and high-net-worth individuals.
- **Maintain Stardust Startups' individuality** and uniqueness as an organization while determining tailored offerings that can be made to attract donors.
- **Develop and form partnerships** with like-minded organizations with the goal of both obtaining financial support and increasing Stardust's visibility as an organization.
- **Increase Stardust Startups' visibility** in the greater non-profit and social impact communities to build legitimacy to attract donors.

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#### Duties and responsibilities

- Collaboratively with the management team, develop and lead fundraising strategy
  - Find and follow up on new funding source opportunities foundations, corporations, individuals, etc.
  - Communicate with previous donors about new donation opportunities build relationships with donors.
  - Plan and execute fundraising campaigns, using data from previous campaigns to maximize impact.
  - Develop creative partnerships and fundraising strategies.
  - Utilize partnership program resources (Sustaining Partnerships, Clubs and Organizations Program, Incubator/Accelerator Partnerships) to grow existing programs.



- Coordinate with management team
  - Weekly Zoom meetings with Managing Director and Director of Operations/Communication
    - Provide updates on Funding and Outreach team progress and activities
    - Advise on strategic decision-making
- Provide structured leadership for Funding and Outreach Team
  - Monitor team members' progress within the F&O internship curriculum
  - Provide guidance and leadership to interns on grant-writing and partnership initiatives
  - Hold weekly F&O Team meetings
    - Post structured agenda to Workplace before meeting
    - Attach shared list of weekly action items to agenda post
  - Participation in the recruitment of the Funding & Outreach interns
- Maximize Stardust's visibility in funding circles by attending events and networking

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#### Other expectations

- Minimum commitment = 9 months from start date
- Leadership and communication on Workplace/Work Chat
- Sign onto and uphold the Professionalism Agreement
- "Out of office": 2-3 weeks notice is ideal when you're scheduling unplugged time beyond 3-4 days
- At this time, the position is considered part-time (approx. 10-15 hours/week)
  - When time and funding are available, can convert into full-time

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Pay

- 30-day unpaid probationary period
- Negotiated monthly stipend (ranging from \$300 \$500)

- Professional or academic experience in one or more of these areas: the nonprofit sector, entrepreneurship, social impact, fundraising, networking
- Proficient + effective in both independent and collaborative work
- Ability to seamlessly integrate into a remote work environment
- Strong communication skills
- Punctuality and organization
- Creativity and out-of-the-box thinking
- Adaptability and willingness to take initiative
